


The 3 seater sofa is made up of a 2 seater section, and a single seater end seat. The 2 seater section has a timber support rail attached underneath for shipping. Remove this using a phillips screwdriver and discard appropriately.


Also on the underside of the sofa there are packages containing the power supplies - cut the ties to remove the packaging and set the power supplies aside.




Step 2

Connect the two seat bases together by lifting the single seater end seat and allowing the pins to fit into the brackets of the 2 seater section from above. There is also one electrical connection to make between them.









Step 3

Identify the backrests for the left-hand side, center and right-hand side - and place them all facing down on the seat bases.




Step 4

Lift each backrest individually to align the metal receivers with the metal posts of the chair base. Allow the posts to slide into the receivers and press down firmly on the top of the backrest until a click is heard on each side.



Step 5

Make the electrical connections per the below diagram:







The 2 seater sofa is made up of the two end seats, and a center console. The two end seats are joined by a timber support rail attached underneath for shipping. Remove this using a phillips screwdriver and discard appropriately.


Also on the underside of the sofa there are packages containing the power supplies - cut the ties to remove the packaging and set the power supplies aside. Inside the center console base zipper compartment is the upright section of the console.




Step 2

Connect the left-hand facing end seat to the center console by lifting the console and allowing the guide pins to fit into the brackets of the LHF end seat from above and press down to secure. There is also one electrical connection to make between them.

Then, connect the right-hand facing end seat to the center console by lifting the RHF seat and allowing the brackets to fit into the brackets of the console section from above.











Step 3

Identify the backrests for the left-hand side, console and right-hand side - and place them facing down on the seat bases.




Step 4

Lift each backrest individually to align the metal receivers with the metal posts of the chair base. Allow the posts to slide into the receivers and press down firmly on the top of the backrest until a click is heard on each side. Perform this step also for the console.

Make the electrical connections per the below diagram:.






Step 3
