① The components are heavy, assembly should be performed by two people.

- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the product.
- This product contains moving parts. Keep fingers, hair and body parts well clear from moving parts. To reduce the risk of injury, keep children and pets clear of the product when in use.

Electrical Instructions

- Never force the back or footrest to close faster than the electric motor.
- Before commencing cleaning or maintenance, ensure this product is disconnected from the power outlet and the back is in the full upright position.
- · Disconnect this product from the power outlet before moving.
- Cease operation and disconnect from the power outlet if you ever detect a burning odour or smoke coming from the product.
- Do not operate this product if liquid spillage occurs on or around it.
 Disconnect from the power outlet and allow product to completely dry before reconnecting.

- Do not sit or place additional weight on the arms, back or open footrest
- This product is very heavy. Only move this product by lifting the main body. Never drag by the footrest, back or arm rest.
- Return this product to the full upright position to stand safely and prevent a tripping hazard.
- · Do not operate this product if damage is visible in any form.
- · Do not modify or use unauthorised substitute parts.
- This product has been designed and intended for indoor residential use only. It is not suitable for commercial or outdoor use.
- This product is not intended to be used as part of a health care plan.
 Consult your medical professional before operating if you are taking medication or have physical limitations.



Step '

Remove the wooden feet from the zippered pockets on the underside of each seat base. Attach the wooden feet to the underside of each seat piece per the below diagram:



Step 2


With two people, carefully turn the seat pieces the right way up and connect the individual base pieces together using the connectors down the side of each seat.






Step 3

Attach the seat back to the seat base for the end seat according to below diagram:




Step 4

Connect the power cable between the end seat's seat base and seat back per below diagram:




Step 5

Connect the plugs between the middle seat and end seat to supply power to the middle seat's heating pad.



Step 6

Connect the *ZB-H290020_A* power supply to the chaise side corner plug and connect to a wall outlet. Connect *ZB-H290030-G* power supply to the seat side corner plug and connect to a wall outlet. Double check the correct power supply has been connected to the correct corner plug before powering on. Connect directly to a wall outlet wherever possible. If a powerboard is required, check that it is sufficiently rated.




Attach the seat backs to the seat bases according to below diagram:


Connect the power cable between the seat seat bases and seat backs per below diagram:


Connect the power supplies to the two bottom corner plugs and connect to a wall outlet. Connect direct to wall outlet instead of multiboards or adaptors wherever possible.







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


With two people, carefully turn the seat the right way up.








Attach the seat back to the seat base according to below diagram:



Step 4


Connect the power cable between the seat base and seat back per below diagram:
